
- **Monthly GB Meeting and CME**




IMA AMS Kazhakoottam conducted an online CME meeting on Zoom platform on 17/01/24, 7:30 pm.





Red flag symptom	Related secondary headache types (referent ICHD-3 categories)
1. Severe symptomatic, recurring headache	Migraine with aura (cyclic, or nonmigraine headache associated with aura)
2. Headache in history	Headaches with history of tension, or tension-like headache
3. Headache or eye pain including eye pain in children	Migraine with aura (cyclic, or nonmigraine headache associated with eye pain)
4. Headache in association with fever or vomiting	Thunderclap headache and other headache associated with fever or vomiting
5. Onset after age 50 (adults)	Given red symptoms and other headache subtypes to consider for cerebral vascular disorders




